Fuel in Bemboka

Please be aware there is no petrol available in Bemboka village. The nearest petrol stations are in either Bega, Cobargo or Cooma.

Dogs are not encouraged but if present must be under control in accordance with the current Companion Animals Act

There are no stables at the showground. Our chief cattle steward requests that if the cattle yards need to be used, please leave them clean and close the gates securely each time they are accessed. Over time, open gates compromise the structure of the yard configuration.

Catering: All day breakfast of Egg & Bacon Roll will complement several selections for lunch. Tea, coffee and a selection of home baking will also be available for sale.

As the community showgrounds are also used by the cricket club, please respect their synthetic pitch and avoid damage to this area. **We have been asked to pick up manure on the main arena.** (A NSW Cricket Association health ruling) Please assist by depositing in the bags provided.

It is a condition of entry that competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with the rules. The National Dressage Rules can be downloaded freely from www.equestrian.org.au Please pay particular attention to **Rule 11.10.2 Etiquette for Warm Up Areas.** This ensures safe riding and achieves harmony in busy areas.

Once again there will be several 'lucky draws' for competitors, horses entered and canteen customers. The **'Lethal Weapon improvers' award'** will be made to the combination who has shown the greatest improvement in % at Bemboka during the year and awarded at the November competition. Ridden by Bemboka local Jake Goodlock, Lethal Weapon (Teddy) competed at the June competition 2011 and on proceeding to State Pony Club ODE representation, performed one of their best dressage results. Sadly, Lethal Weapon developed a health issue that he did not survive. This award is in his memory.
